

Painting Florals Materials List

Please purchase the best quality materials you can afford. Quality does make a difference. See my FAQ sheet for suggestions on all supplies.

If you have painted in watercolors before you can bring what you have.

Paints: one tube each watercolor paint. Permanent Rose, Cobalt Blue, Sap Green and Lemon or Aureolin and any colors you usually like to use.

Brushes: one 1" or 1-1/2" good wash brush and one #10 or 12 round

Paper: 140 lb. Cold Press (expensive so use your Michaels or AC Moore coupons). Or order on line from one of the many art supply companies.

Water container: Plastic tubs from margarine or divided plastic containers used for food storage make good containers. Try supermarket or Dollar Stores.

Board: You will need some kind of board to clip your paper on.

Misc. Sketch Book: 6 x 9 or 8 x 10 , Sketch Pencils: 3B (do not use hard pencils as they damage the watercolor paper) and a notebook to jot down my words of wisdom ☺

Camera. I allow students to take photos during the demonstration.
