The Member Show Is Almost Here! Some reminders:



Judge: Ann DerGara is a painter, printmaker, and owner of the Red Wolf Gallery in Brevard where she moved 19 years ago to escape the hectic life of Atlanta. DerGara is also helping to build Brevard's now-thriving art scene and the art-and-craft corridor on US 276-South. Update on ArtScape for 2022

The ArtScape Banners are the most visible contribution that the Art League makes to the City of Hendersonville. Because of COVID, banners from 2020 have stayed up through 2021. We are in the process of recruiting sponsors and are ready to call for artists to submit applications for banners to be hung in 2022. All county artists, both 2-D and 3-D are eligible to apply.

The banner application process is described on the ArtScape website and in two 15-minute videos made from the League's October Zoom meeting. Applications will be taken only through the CaFÉ on-line system.
